1. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY LISA VAN LIEW AT 7:30 P.M.
2. THE ROLL CALL WAS TAKEN. VAN LIEW, PRESENT, DUNN, PRESENT. GREEN, PRESENT. OWENS, PRESENT. HALL, PRESENT. A QUORUM WAS PRESENT.
3. TO DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF NEW BUSINESS:
 - A. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING THE PROPOSED DISBANDING OF THE ZONING COMMITTEE BASED UPON PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED MAY 8, 2023. VAN LIEW MENTIONED THAT THE BOARD WAS TRYING TO BE PROACTIVE REGARDING POTENTIAL DEVELOPMENT DUE TO THE IMPENDING WIDENING OF HIGHWAY 9. THEY WANT TO KEEP PINK A RURAL COMMUNITY. THE DRAFT ORDINANCE WAS EXCESSIVELY RESTRICTIVE AND SHE WOULD NOT HAVE VOTED FOR IT THE WAY IT WAS WRITTEN. BASED ON PUBLIC COMMENTS RECEIVED AT THE MAY 8 ZONING BOARD MEETING AND TOWN MEETING SHE BELIEVES IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE TOWN TO DISBAND THE ZONING COMMITTEE AND NOT MOVE FORWARD WITH A ZONING ORDINANCE. IF IN THE FUTURE, CITIZENS OF PINK WANT SOME ZONING GUIDELINES, THEY CAN BRING THEIR CONCERNS TO THE TOWN BOARD AND DISCUSS FORMING A NEW COMMITTEE. VAN LIEW MADE A MOTION TO DISBAND THE ZONING COMMITTEE. GREEN SECONDED THE MOTION. VAN LIEW YEA, DUNN YEA, GREEN YEA, OWENS YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.
