1. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY LISA VAN LIEW AT 7:31 P.M.
2. THE ROLL CALL WAS TAKEN. DUNN, PRESENT. VAN LIEW, PRESENT. GREEN, PRESENT. MILLER, PRESENT. HALL, PRESENT. A QUORUM WAS PRESENT.
3. THE MINUTES OF THE MARCH MEETING WERE PRESENTED TO THE BOARD. GREEN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MARCH MEETING MINUTES. DUNN SECONDED THE MOTION. DUNN YEA, VAN LIEW YEA, GREEN YEA, MILLER YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.
4. THE MARCH FINANCIAL REPORT WAS READ BY ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. DUNN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT. MILLER SECONDED THE MOTION. DUNN YEA, VAN LIEW YEA, GREEN YEA, MILLER YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.
5. TO DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF OLD BUSINESS:
 - A. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS FOR INCREASED FUTURE UTILIZATION OF TOWN PROPERTY.
 - i. VAN LIEW WOULD LIKE TO HAVE NEW DOORS AND ROLL UP DOOR INSTALLED ON KITCHEN SO THAT IT CAN BE CLOSED OFF. VAN LIEW MADE A MOTION TO PROCEED WITH CLOSING OFF THE KITCHEN NOT TO EXCEED \$5,000. HALL SECONDED THE MOTION. DUNN YEA, VAN LIEW YEA, GREEN YEA, MILLER YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.
6. TO DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF NEW BUSINESS:
 - A. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION TO ADOPT RESOLUTION DECLARING A NUISANCE AT 20768 WALKER ROAD AND 23483 FOREST DRIVE. TOWN ATTORNEY LASTER EXPLAINED THAT A LETTER HAD BEEN SENT TO BOTH PROPERTY OWNERS. FOREST DRIVE RESPONDED AND HAS BEGUN CLEANING UP PROPERTY. NO RESPONSE FROM WALKER ROAD PROPERTY. ATTORNEY LASTER EXPLAINED THE PROCESS IF THE TOWN WANTED TO ISSUE A NUISANCE RESOLUTION. TRUSTEES DISCUSSED HAVING ATTORNEY LASTER REACH OUT AGAIN AND LET OWNERS KNOW OF UPCOMING TOWN DUMP DAY AND ALLOW MORE TIME FOR THEM TO RESPOND. NO ACTION REQUIRED.
 - B. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING TOWN DUMP DAY. VAN LIEW DISCUSSED TOWN DUMP DAY. MAY 9 WAS SUGGESTED AS FIRST CHOICE FOR DATE IF TRASH COMPANY HAS AVAILABILITY. GREEN MADE A MOTION TO PROCEED WITH A TOWN DUMP DAY. MILLER SECONDED THE MOTION. DUNN YEA, VAN LIEW YEA, GREEN YEA, MILLER YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.
 - C. DISCUSSION REGARDING FY2007 TOWN BUDGET. VAN LIEW EXPLAINED THE BUDGET PROCESS. NO ACTION REQUIRED.
