- 3. THE MINUTES OF THE FEBRUARY MEETING WERE PRESENTED TO THE BOARD. OWENS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE MINUTES. HALL SECONDED THE MOTION. VAN LIEW YEA, OWENS YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.
- 4. THE FEBRUARY FINANCIAL REPORT WAS READ BY ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. OWENS MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AS PRESENTED. HALL SECONDED THE MOTION. VAN LIEW YEA, OWENS YEA, HALL YEA. MOTION PASSES.

  - A. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS FOR INCREASED FUTURE UTILIZATION OF TOWN PROPERTY.
    - i. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING NEXT PHASES OF PROJECT FOR PARK IMPROVEMENTS AT 22058 PINK LANE, PINK, OKLAHOMA 74873. VAN LIEW DISCUSSED A QUOTE FOR A PORTABLE TOILET TO BE PLACED BY THE PLAYGROUND. HALL MADE A MOTION TO PROCEED WITH THE RENTAL OF THE PORTABLE TOILET FOR A YEAR. OWENS SECONDED THE MOTION.
