- 1. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY LISA VAN LIEW AT 7:30 P.M.
- 2. THE ROLL CALL WAS TAKEN. VAN LIEW, PRESENT, DUNN, PRESENT. GREEN, PRESENT. EMERT, PRESENT. HALL, ABSENT. A QUORUM WAS PRESENT.
- 3. THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING WERE PRESENTED TO THE BOARD. DUNN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS PRESENTED. GREEN SECONDED THE MOTION. VAN LIEW YEA, DUNN YEA, GREEN YEA, EMERT YEA.
- 4. THE FINANCIAL REPORT WAS READ BY ALL MEMBERS PRESENT. DUNN MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE REPORT AS PRESENTED. GREEN SECONDED THE MOTION. VAN LIEW YEA, DUNN YEA, GREEN YEA. EMERT YEA.
- 5. TO DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF OLD BUSINESS:
 - A. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING REPAIRS/REMODEL OF TOWN HALL. VAN LIEW STATED SHE IS STILL IN CONTACT WITH RANDY THOMAS IN REGARDS TO HIS RECOMENDATIONS ON DRAFTSMEN.
 - B. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING CARES ACT CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS. VAN LIEW STATED ALL PURCHASES HAVE BEEN SUBMITTED AND APPROVED FOR REIMBURSEMENT BY THE STATE EXCEPT FOR THE 4 STANDING HAND SANITIZER DISPENSERS AND THEIR ACCESSORIES. DUNN QUESTIONED WHAT THE DOCUMENTED COMPUTER EQUIPMENT CHARGE WAS FOR. VAN LIEW STATED IS WAS FOR APPLE PENS TO ACCOMPANY THE IPADS PURCHASED WITH CARES FUNDING. VAN LIEW STATED THERE IS APPROXIMATELY 100K LEFT TO SPEND OUT OF THE CARES FUNDING. SHE REQUESTED PURCHASE SUGGESTIONS TO MAKE USE OF FUNDS LEFT. GREEN ASKED WHAT CORONAVIRUS EQUIPMENT HAD BEEN PURCHASED FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT. VAN LIEW STATED PPE, RACKS, EXTRACTOR, GLOVES, AND A BACKPACK SANITIZER MISTER HAD BEEN PURCHASED THUS FAR. GREEN SUGGESTED USING THE MAJORITY OF REMAINING FUNDS TO PURCHASE PPE GEAR FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT.

- 9. TO HEAR REPORTS FROM OFFICERS, BOARDS AND COMMITTEES:
 - A FIRE DEPARTMENT (ROB VAN LIEW): THERE WERE 1 RUNS DURING SEPTEMBER 11 MEDICAL CALLS, 1 MOTOR VEHICULE ACCIDENT, 1 MUTUAL AIDS, 1 CAR FIRE. ROB VAN LIEW STATED 10 BATTERIES NEED TO BE PURCHASED FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, TOTALING APPROXIMATELY \$1050.00. CAPTAIN DANNY COKER STATED POWER TOOLS NEED TO BE PURCHASED TO EQUIP THE NEW TANKER TRUCK. COKER ALSO STATED TANKER 1 IS OUT OF SERVICE AND A COMPLETE SERVICE TUNE UP IS NEEDED FOR NEW TANKER.
 - B. SENIOR CITIZEN'S CENTER (BILL EMERT): EMERT STATED AN AVERAGE OF 15 MEALS PER DAY WERE SERVED IN AUGUST. 66 TOTAL MEALS WERE SERVED IN SEPTEMBER. THE SENIOR CENTER OFFICALLY STOPPED SERVING MEALS TO THE PUBLIC SEPTEMBER 15, 2020. EMERT HAD SPOKEN TO THE COUNTY COMMISIONER WHO SAID 8 OUT OF 11 LOCAL SENIOR CENTERS HAVE BEEN SHUT DOWN DUE TO COVID-19. THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA WILL CONTINUE TO ASSIST IN THE MONTHY EXPENSES OF THE SENIOR CENTER. NO COEDD FUNDING RECEIVED YET. VAN LIEW ASKED EMERT IF THE SENIOR CENTER WILL NEED ANY ADDITIONAL HELP FOR THE UPCOMING VOTING HELD THERE. EMERT SAID HELP WOULD BE NEEDED SETTING UP AND DISINFECTING THE BUILDING AFTER THE EVENT. ROB VAN LIEW SUGGESTED HANDING OUT FREE PPE KITS PURCHASED WITH THE CARES FUNDING DURING POLLING HOURS.
