ORDINANCE NO. 44

THIRD AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 11, ORIGINALLY DATED JANUARY 3, 1977, OF THE TOWN OF PINK, OKLAHOMA; PROVIDING FOR MILEAGE REIMBURSEMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees have determined that an amendment to its Code of Ordinances must be made for the more efficient and practical operations for the Town of Pink; and accordingly,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees herein have determined that the [Second] Amending Ordinance of Ordinance No. 11, dated November 11, 2002, shall remain in place, un-amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees herein have determined that Ordinance No. 11, and all its prior Amendments, shall be amended as follows herein providing for mileage reimbursement; and,

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board that this Amending Ordinance be harmonized with original Ordinance No. 11, and its subsequent Amendments, and to the extend there exists a conflict, the latter shall apply.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF PINK, POTTAWATOMIE COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1 AMENDATORY: Section 5 of Ordinance No. 11 shall state as follows:

Volunteer Fire Fighters shall be entitled to a reimbursement for mileage actually and necessarily driven when responding to emergency calls from the location of the Volunteer Fire Fighter's primary residence to the closer of (1) the nearest Town fire station or (2) the location of the emergency call. The Town Board will determine by resolution the reimbursement rate with regards to the mileage reimbursement.

SECTION 2 EMERGENCY. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, safety and public good of the Town of Pink and the inhabitants thereof that the provisions of this Ordinance be put into full force and effect, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after its passage, as provided by law. PASSED AND APPROVED and the emergency clause voted on separately this day of June, 2022
